About the role

We are seeking experienced educators for an exciting leadership opportunity within our Learning Diversity team. This role is ideal for a teacher who is passionate about supporting students with diverse learning needs, implementing practical, student-centred changes to learning, and advocating for students to ensure they are supported to engage in their learning.

Working alongside a team of 7 Learning Diversity Leaders, this role will support teachers to plan, implement and review learning programs and resources to ensure they are accessible, differentiated and responsive to student needs. A key part of this role is the case management of students, coordinating their learning supports, communicating with families and external professionals, facilitating Parent Support Group meetings, monitoring student progress, and ensuring Individualised Learning Plans (ILP) are developed, implemented, reviewed and adjusted as required.

To be successful in this role, you will need a strong understanding of effective, evidence-based teaching practices for differentiated curriculum, experience in case management and ILP development, and the ability to provide practical professional mentoring to teachers.

This is a permanent, full-time teaching role, commencing in Term 1, 2026. A position of leadership allowance (POL 2) plus generous time release (400 minutes) will be allocated until January 2027.
